Containerized Ambulance Vessel

Heavy – duty vessels



These are heavy-duty vessels manufactured from Marine Grade Aluminium 5083-H116, specifically designed for Ambulance and rescue work in shallow waterways if necessary.

They can be shipped in a standard 40HQ shipping container ready for immediate use

The hull design is a Twin Hull Catamaran. An important aspect of the catamaran hull is that as well as the superior stability capabilities, they have an amazing low draught to enable access in shallow waters of only 380mm.

Internally the vessels are fully equipped with one gurney station for patients, seating for three staff and the helm seat for the driver. Cabinets are all manufactured from hospital grade stainless steel.

High Speed ICU Ambulance



The 13.00-meter High-Speed ICU Ambulance can navigate shallow coastal waters with 6 x ICU stations or seating capacity for 40

Shuttle Ferries Capable Beach Landing



Shallow draft Catamaran vessel that can come onto the beach and collect up to 150 patients, then transport them to the Mother Ship and return for another load

Landing Craft



Landing craft are small to medium sized vessels capable of moving heavy loads of equipment and personal to and from beach landing. They come in sizes from 16.00 meters up to 74.00 meters

General Hospital Catamaran 60 Meter



These General Hospital Cats are all fully self-contained with live on-board accommodation for the medical staff as well as the crew. The 60-meter vessel has been designed for coastal use as well as being able to travel up rivers to isolated communities. The vessels are all modern in the Naval design as well as being fully functional General Hospitals on the water



The vessels come fitted with state-of-the-art medical equipment ready to work

General Hospital Ship 160 Meter



This vessel has been designed to be used as a High-Volume General Hospital on the water. They have the ability to accommodate any task from, Immunisation Programs to Intricate Surgical Operations in one of the 4 modern Operating Theatres with Doctors carrying out on the spot lifesaving work anywhere in the world, on the water



The 160 will function very well as a mother ship capable of servicing the vast remote areas in the South Pacific Region. This Mother ship can dock alongside deep-water Ports or anchor offshore to successfully carry out large scale Immunisation Programs as well as functioning as a General Hospital



High Quality live onboard accommodation for personal, includes medical personal up to 90 with the ship's crew of up to 16. Patients are catered for with 400 ward beds that can accommodate lengthy stays onboard to allow for full recovery. Emergency is catered for with 50 well equipped ICU stations



The vessel is self-contained with a fully operational Commercial Kitchen, Laundry, water making equipment



Entertainment for live on board personal is catered for with a dedicated floor incorporating the Dining, Audio Visual and Reading areas to cater for recreation during down time

Air Ambulance



Air Ambulances are specially outfitted helicopters that transports injured or sick people in a medical emergency or over distances or terrain impractical for a conventional ground ambulance

Like ground ambulances, air ambulances are equipped with medical equipment vital to monitoring and treating injured or ill patients. A medically staffed and equipped Air Ambulance provides medical care whilst in flight

Common equipment for air ambulances includes medications, ventilators, ECGs and monitoring units, CPR equipment, and stretchers

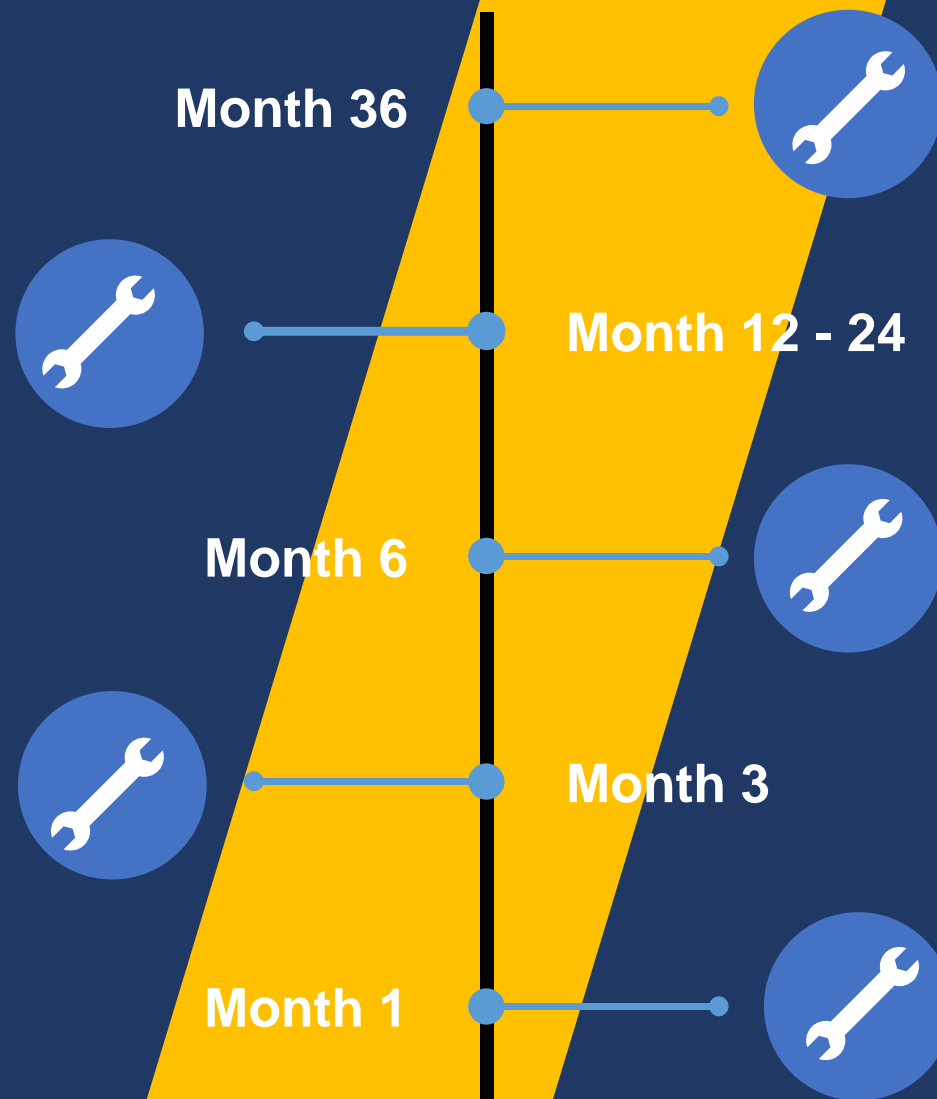
Typical Aircraft will be a Bell 407 with hours between 1800 to 2500
